Additional notes:

 - **If you use screenshots SAY SO in your description** (sometimes a photos can look like a screenshot, and it will be up to the instructor's discretion to decide whether if the image is original - if not, see last bullet point below)
- You CAN use photos from visits to the observatory, or any other participation activity, but it cannot be the same one you submitted to get participation marks for that activity
- The photos/images must have been taken this semester (no using photos of the full moon from your week at the cabin last summer)
- Submit the photos & descriptions in 1 document

- All photo assignments will be marked after the March 31st due date.
- The mark will be given as a total out of 15 and will be worth 5% of the final grade.

- **Students will receive a zero on the assignment if it is found that any of the images used are not their own**
